



FURTHER STUDY

Students of Victoria International College who attain a proficient level of English may be able to enrol for courses at one of Australia's universities or other tertiary institutions which offer diploma and degree courses. The English for Academic Purposes course is designed to help overseas students gain the necessary language skills for further study at an Australian tertiary institution.

Warrnambool Institute of Advanced Education and Victoria International College have combined resources to offer "Headstart". This is a "bridging" course which guarantees entry to various WIAE degree courses upon successful completion. The first year of the various WIAE degree courses offered through "Headstart" will be taught at Victoria International College.

EXCURSIONS

Excursions play a great role in the active learning process of Victoria International College. Through visits to various cultural places in Melbourne, such as the Arts Centre or the Queen Victoria Market, students are taught how to put into practice their English skills. The visits are coordinated with classes at the College, making them an enjoyable and useful learning experience.

C L A S S E S

All the teachers at Victoria International College are fully qualified and experienced teachers of English as a Foreign Language. The College uses an active approach to teach English, with an emphasis on communication. Through the use of "real life" situations, students speak and listen, as well as read and write, to learn English properly and effectively. The lessons at the College are designed to teach students how to communicate with native speakers of English in both specific and everyday situations.



FACILITIES

Victoria International College has a Self Access Centre which is fully equipped with audio-visual equipment. Students can practise their listening skills using the College's collection of taped resources or in discussion with other students. Newspapers, magazines, books and other resource materials are freely available to enable the students to improve their reading and writing skills.

The College has large and pleasant classrooms, a student lounge and common room, and resources to cater for every student's needs. Students can expect lively and stimulating courses in English, taught by extremely competent staff.



ASSESSMENT

The students' English skills are assessed on the first day to place them in a class to suit their needs. Assessment continues during the course, to see that the students are achieving their academic goals. Students at Victoria International College are given an evaluation every five weeks, to show the student's progress in the course. At the end of their English course, each student is presented with a Certificate of Proficiency, an Attendance Record and an Evaluation Record detailing their academic achievements.

COURSE DETAILS



ACCOMMODATION

Students attending Victoria International College will be able to obtain assistance with accommodation from the Melbourne Council for Overseas Students. For a small charge students can be met at the airport and taken to temporary accommodation until suitable permanent accommodation has been arranged. Accommodation can be in hostels, in houses or flats shared with other students, in a private home with either full board or in a furnished bedroom with use of a kitchen.

Accommodation will cost between \$A85 and \$A125 per week for full board or for hostel accommodation. A room in a private home, or sharing with other students will cost between \$A55 and \$A65 per week, with food an additional \$A45 to \$A55 per week

PART-TIME WORK

Overseas students in Australia are permitted to obtain part-time work for up to 20 hours per week. Many students take advantage of this opportunity to earn extra money while they are studying. Work is however not always easy to obtain, and it may be several weeks before suitable work can be found.

FEES AND OTHER COSTS

Tuition fees at Victoria International College cover the use of the Self-Access Centre and all student amenities, including the student lounge and common room, and curriculum material provided in class.

CONDITIONS OF ENROLMENT

Your international bankdraft in Australian dollars should include a non-refundable Administration charge of \$100, the course fee and the optional charges for MELCOS services.

CANCELLATION

All fees, except the Administration Fee are fully refundable if notice of withdrawal is given at least 28 days before commencement. Except under unusual circumstances, and at the discretion of the Principal, fees will not be refunded if students withdraw during a course.

T H E C O U R S E


HEADSTART runs for 16 weeks and students will be required to attend classes for a minimum of sixteen hours per week. They will also be required to work on their own for another twenty hours per week. Students without a proficient entry level of English will be required to attend extra classes in English to meet the examination requirements.

Students proficient in Mathematics may undertake the examination before commencement of classes. Success in the examination will exempt the student from attendance of classes.

Successful completion of the HEADSTART program will guarantee entry to the following WIAE degree problems:

- Bachelor of Arts (Management Communication)*
- Bachelor of Business (Accounting)*
- Bachelor of Business (Applied Economics)
- Bachelor of Business (Computing)
- Bachelor of Social Science *

*Offered at VIC (Melbourne) in 1990, students wishing to undertake the Computing degree will be required to attend the Warrnambool campus.
